- In cooperation with the District Key-4, act as a point of contact for people within your district who have questions about special needs Scouting.
- Make copies of the resources that may help answer questions/concerns about special needs. Keep and promote updates as you receive them from the council special needs committee.
- Promote the inclusion of special needs youth through district events and district roundtables.
- Give leadership to achieving national "Quality District" status with continued growth to the District and Northern Star Council.

- Attend monthly District Committee Meetings
- Attend monthly district roundtable Meetings.
- Attend council Special Needs Committee Meeting.
- Attend an annual council planning meeting for district special needs resource volunteers.
