



Order of the Arrow Vigil Honor



The Vigil Honor is the highest honor that the Order of the Arrow can bestow upon its members for service to lodge, council, and Scouting. Membership cannot be earned by a person's conscious endeavors, but is recognized by their peers for outstanding service and devotion to the ideals of the Order of the Arrow.

To be nominated, members must be Brotherhood members for 2 or more years and be a member in good standing with the Boy Scouts and the OA. The Lodge may nominate up to 2% of their membership for the Vigil Honor. At least 50% of Lodge nominations must be given to youth awardees.
