Our courses fill up quickly, so please register early and don't miss this excellent training opportunity. **This course is also a fantastic introduction for parents or other adults in the Troop that are interested in learning more about Boy Scouts and how Troops function.**

Participants will complete the following course

Spend the weekend camping as members of "Troop 2016"

Where: At Three Rivers Carver Park in Victoria, MN

When: Arrive Friday evening Sep 30 and Leave Saturday evening Oct 1, 2016

What: All participants will review the outdoor skills required to earn First Class rank (Camping, Cooking, First Aid, and more!) while learning leadership and practicing teamwork within your assigned patrols.

Pre-work:

In order to complete all the training requirements and be considered fully trained, there will be some pre-work required. Participants will be contacted prior to the course with the requirements. Pre-work typically involves reading and review of training materials, and the completion of basic training, which is 'This is Scouting' AND 'Youth Protection Training'. Participants will be asked to verify completion of pre requisites before the course.

Supplies:

Participants are expected to supply their own tents, personal camping items, and shared patrol camping equipment. Your food will be provided on Saturday. Individual patrols will cook breakfast together on Sunday morning. Bring a snack to share for the cracker barrel on Friday night.

Cost:

\$40.00 per participant. The cost covers materials, facility fees, and meals for the class.
