UNIT ELECTION PROCEDURE :

- 1. Hold the election at the time and place determined by the unit leader, and have Boy Scouts or Varsity Scouts assembled with their unit leader ready to elect candidates. The Order of the Arrow should be represented by a two or threemember team from the chapter unit elections committee.
- 2. **Before** the election the unit leader certifies that at least half of the registered and active youth members are present. An election should not be held with less than half of the active registered members present. An alternate date can be set for a future election.
- 3. The **unit leader certifies** the eligible youth members on the election report form.
 - All members of, or candidates for membership in, the Order of the Arrow who are under 21 years of age shall be considered youth members or candidates for youth membership, subject to meeting the following requirements:
 - Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
 - Hold the First Class rank of the Boy Scouts of America as a minimum.
 - After registration with a troop or team, have experienced fifteen days and nights of camping, during the two-year period prior to the election. The fifteen days and night **must** include six consecutive days and nights of resident camping, approved and under the auspices and standards of the BSA. The balance of the camping must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps (no further resident camp days are allowed).
- 4. A youth candidate must receive at least 50% of the votes submitted. The youth may vote for all, any, or none of the candidates. A youth may refrain from submitting a ballot if he does not feel capable of making an informed decision.
- 5. The unit leader may choose to announce results immediately. The Unit Election report must be completely filled out and returned to the election team <u>on the night of the election</u>. No exceptions please.
- 6. The election team should give the signed "pink" copy to the unit leader.
- 7. If one or more youth candidates were elected the unit may submit adult nomination(s). See separate adult nomination form for details.
