NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS)*; *The BSA Guide to Safe Scouting*; *Sailing Instructions*; and *this Official Notice of Race* and all applicable rules of conduct.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) shall be the BSA as represented by an appointed Wayzata Sailing Staff member on location with additional support provided by the Race Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Teams will be formed by 2 sailors (a skipper and crew).
- 2.2. Participants must be registered participants in good standing of a BSA Sea Scout Ship.
- 2.3. Participants must be at least 14 years old and less than 21 years old.

3. ENTRY

- 3.1. A maximum of 16 teams may enter the event
- 3.2. A minimum of 4 teams must be entered before the registration deadline, for the event to be considered a 2020 Koch Cup Qualifier
- 3.3. Registration will be collected online through Regatta Toolbox:

- 3.4. Entry fee \$35 per sailor (\$70 per team)
- 3.5. In addition to registration fee, a damage deposit of \$125 per sailor / \$250 per team will be held during the event. (Refundable after damage free boat inspection)
- 3.6. The registration deadline will be end of day August 16th, 2019
- 3.7. A minimum of 4 teams must be registered before the deadline or the event may be cancelled or the schedule modified

4. BOATS

- 4.1. Z420 boats with mainsail and jib will be provided by the host
- 4.2. Boats shall be sailed as provided by the host. No changes to purchase or standing rigging shall be made by competitors

6. VENUE

- 6.1. Please obey all no parking signs on Arlington circle, as well as keeping mind not to block driveway entrances or garage doors. Parking location is 1100 Eastman Lane, Wayzata, Minnesota, 55391

7. COURSES

- 7.1. Courses sailed will be announced and explained during the competitors meeting on both Saturday and Sunday.
- 7.2. Courses are intended to take approximately 25-35 minutes apiece, and laid out in a standard windward leeward format.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A

9. PRIZES

9.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams

9.2. The Crew with the lowest overall series point score in the fleet shall win the Wayzata Sailing Sea Scout Regatta and earn the right to be listed as the first alternate crew in line to receive an invitation to the 2020 William I. Koch International Sea Scout Cup in Galveston, TX in July 2020 (Provided that the required minimum number of teams compete, winning team members are at least at apprentice rank by 01/01/2020, and be at least 14 years old and less than 21 years old on 07/01/2020.)

Note: Wayzata Sailing Sea Scout Regatta is the 6th and last submitted 2019 Koch Cup Qualifier for the Central Region. As such, the first place winning team will be listed as 1st alternate team for Central Region, instead of receiving an automatic invitation to the 2020 William I. Koch International Sea Scout Cup in Galveston, TX in July 2020

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority and Wayzata Sailing will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. ¹
